



Add Questions to an Exam

This guide shows how to add a set number of randomly selected questions from a question bank into a Moodle exam. Using random questions creates unique exam versions for each student, improving fairness and security while keeping the overall difficulty consistent.

Adding Random Questions to an Exam

1. Select the desired category from the '**Match**' dropdown menu. This action filters the questions from that specific question bank.
2. In the '**Number of random questions**' dropdown, specify the number of questions you wish to add to the exam.
3. After selecting both the category and the desired number of questions, click the '**APPLY FILTERS**' button.
4. Finally, click the '**ADD RANDOM QUESTION**' button to finalize your selection and add the filtered questions to the exam.
